- ✓ The **races** are held as second leg of the **SKODA-Cross-Cup**, organized by the FSCL. The full regulations of this series can be found at <http://www.skoda-crosscup.com/rules>.
- ✓ **Start and Finish** are located in the rue de Moutfort, at the exit of the village Contern.
- ✓ The **permanent office** is located in a bus in the rue de Moutfort, at the entrance of the course. It is open between 12.00 and 16.30 o'clock.
- ✓ **Anti-doping controls** can be performed by the Luxemburgish Anti-Doping Agency (Agence Luxembourgeoise Anti-Dopage - ALAD) If so, they are taking place in the changing rooms of the old Sports Centrum rue des Sports in Contern

REGULATIONS – 29th GP COMAT

- ✓ The 29th Grand-prix COMAT is held on **Sunday, October 16, 2016** according to the rules of the [Union Cycliste Internationale \(UCI\)](#) and the [Fédération du Sport Cycliste Luxembourgeois \(FSCL\)](#).
- ✓ It is a cyclo-cross registered in the calendars of the FSCL and the UCI and open to following categories: **women, junior-women, novices and juniors**. Riders from the **masters** category are not aligned to line up as the race is an international one.
- ✓ **Starts** of the different categories are in the rue de Moutfort according to following schedule:
 - 14h00** – Juniors (**international UCI cyclo-cross**)
 - 14h01** – Women and junior-women (**international UCI cyclo-cross category 2**)
 - 14h02** – Novices (**regional cyclo-cross**)
- ✓ The **duration of the race** has to approach **30 minutes** as much as possible for the novices as well as **40 minutes** as much as possible for the women, junior-women and juniors. The exact number of laps to be covered will be decided by the jury during the event.
- ✓ Three separate **result lists** are established, one for the novices, one for the women and junior-women and one for the junior category. (no separate rankings for junior-women).
- ✓ The **award ceremony** takes place immediately after the finish on the podium next to the finish line. The three first riders of the races for novices, women and juniors have to attend it as well as the first the best junior-woman.
- ✓ **Prices** are according to the FSCL and UCI regulations :

- ✓ At the end of the races and according to the result lists, points are rewarded for the **UCI Cyclo-cross rankings** (only international races for juniors and women) and for the overall result of the **FSCL SKODA-Cross-cup**.

REGULATIONS – 12th GP Commune de Contern

- ✓ The 12th Grand-prix de la Commune de Contern is held on **Sunday, October 16, 2016** according to the rules of the [Union Cycliste Internationale \(UCI\)](#) and the [Fédération du Sport Cycliste Luxembourgeois \(FSCL\)](#). **Start of the race** is at à **15.15** o'clock in Contern (rue de Mouffort at the exit of the village).
- ✓ It is an international cyclo-cross registered in the calendars of the FSCL and the UCI and open to **elite and U23** categories. **Masters** are not aligned to line up as the race is an international one.
- ✓ The **duration of the race** has to approach **60 minutes** as much as possible. The exact number of laps to be covered will be decided by the jury during the race.
- ✓ One **result list** is established only. (no separate rankings for U23 riders thus).
- ✓ The **award ceremony** takes place immediately after the finish on the podium next to the finish line. The three first riders of the race as well as the first rider from Luxemburg and the first U23 rider have to attend it.
