

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The 46th International Cyclo-cross of the ACC Contern is held in **Contern** on **October 30, 2021** under the denominations **16th Grand-prix de la Commune de Contern** and **33rd Grand-prix COMAT**. It is organized according to the rules of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) and the Fédération du Sport Cycliste Luxembourgeois (FSCL).
- **Organizer** is the ACC Contern, represented by Mr Alain Conter, 47, Op der Hobuch, L-5832 Fentange, Tél : +352 621 23 16 45, e-mail : acccontern@gmail.com
- It is an international event of **UCI class 2 (C2)** for the categories men junior, women junior, U23 and elite and men U23 and elite.
- The event is held under the **COVID-Check** rules of the Luxemburg Government. All persons involved have to respect the Anti-Covid regulations and guidelines of the organizer.
- The races are held as round 2 of the **SKODA-Cross-Cup** series which is organized by the FSCL. The full regulations of this series can be found on <http://www.skoda-crosscup.com/rules>.
- **Pre-registration** for the different races is mandatory until Thursday, October 28, 2021. It can be done online on the internet-site of the FSCL (<http://fsc.lu/inscription-online/>) or by sending a message to the organizer (e-mail acccontern@gmail.com) with following informations: Name, First Name, UCI-Code, Team or Club, Category, Gender, Nationality and Year of Birth. If you are in possession of a transponder that works with the **MyLaps system**, please use it during the race and provide the code of the transponder upon registration. There are no registration fees for the race, but the organizer will charge 10 EUR renting fee to riders that have to rent their transponder.

- There will be no **official reception** with prize distribution. Riders of all categories can have their prizes at the permanent office about an hour after the finish of their respective race.
- **Anti-doping controls** can be performed by the Luxemburgish Anti-Doping Agency (Agence Luxembourgeoise Anti-Dopage - ALAD). If so, they are taking place in the changing rooms of the Sports Centrum « Um Ewent », situated at 41, rue de Syren in L-5316 Contern



REGULATIONS :

16th Grand-prix de la Commune de CONTERN

- ✓ The 16th Grand-Prix de la Commune de Contern is an international cyclo-cross on the FSCL and the UCI calendar (C2 – Class 2) and it is open to the **elite and U23 categories** (ME C2 – Class 2). **Masters** are not allowed to line up as the race is an international one.
- ✓ **Start** of the race is at à **15.15 o'clock** in Contern (rue de Moutfort at the exit of the village).
- ✓ The **duration** of the race has to approach 60 minutes as much as possible. The exact number of laps to be covered will be decided by the jury during the race.
- ✓ One **result list** is established only. There are no separate rankings for U23 riders.
- ✓ The **award ceremony** takes place immediately after the finish on the podium next to the finish line. The three first riders of the race have to attend it, as well as the first rider from Luxemburg and the first U23 rider if they are not already among the three first of the race.
- ✓ **Prizes** are according to the FSCL and UCI regulations and can be picked up at the official reception which is held at 17h00 o'clock in the Sports Centre « Um Event ».

33rd Grand-prix COMAT

- ✓ The 33rd Grand-Prix Comat is a cyclo-cross race that is open to following categories **novices** (male / female), **juniors** (male) as well as all **female categories** (elite, U23, juniors).
- ✓ The races for the categories **juniors and women** (including U23 women and juniors) are **international races** on the UCI calendar (C2 – Class 2). **Masters** are not allowed to line up with the juniors as the race is an international one. The race for novices (m/f) is a regional race on the FSCL calendar.
- ✓ **Starts** of the different categories are in Contern according to following schedule:
 - 12h00 – Novices** (male / female) (regional cyclo-cross)
 - 13h00 – Junior men** (international UCI cyclo-cross C2 – Class 2)
 - 14h00 – Elite, U23 and junior women** (international UCI cyclo-cross C2 – Class 2)
- ✓ The **duration** of the race has to approach **30 minutes** as much as possible for the novices (m/f), **40 minutes** as much as possible for juniors and **45 minutes** for the female categories. The exact number of laps to be covered will be decided by the jury during the event.
- ✓ Three separate **result lists** are established, one for the novices (m/f), one for the elite, U23 and junior women and one for the junior men category. (There are no separate rankings for female novices, for U23 women and for junior women but their position within their category will be marked on the list).
- ✓ The **award ceremony** takes place immediately after the finish on the podium next to the finish line. Have to attend it: for the novices, the three best riders of the race and the best rider from a category (male/female) that is not represented on the podium yet, for the juniors, the three best riders of the race, for the women, the three best riders of the race and the best rider from each category (juniors, U23, elite) that is not represented on the podium yet.
- ✓ **Prizes** are according to the FSCL and UCI regulations and can be picked up about an hour after the finish of each race at the permanent office.
